



Prohibit and Regulate the Sale and Setting Off of Fireworks

Fireworks – No person shall set off Consumer Fireworks within the Municipality of Highlands East at any time except as follows:

- a. New Year's Eve – between 7:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. the following day;
- b. Victoria Day – between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the weekend preceding and including the statutory holiday;
- c. Canada Day – between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. the weekend prior to Canada Day, the weekend directly following Canada Day or on July 1st;
- d. Civic Holiday – between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the weekend preceding and including the statutory holiday;
- e. Labour Day – between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the weekend preceding and including the statutory holiday.

Flying Lantern – No person shall ignite, release or set off into the air an ignited Flying Lantern within the Municipality of Highlands East.

Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act R.O.S. 1990, c. P. 33, as amended.
